January 3, 2019

Mayor Richardson called the meeting to order at 7:00pm Thursday, Jan 3, 2019. The pledge of allegiance was given by Benson Taylor and the prayer given by Nicole Weight.

USDA – Loan/Grant Program:

Lana Duke cancelled due to the federal government shut down.

Public Works – Curb side pickup service:

Mitch Bradley came forward and expressed his concern with the cost of the ongoing curb side pickup service for the disposal of lawn clippings. The cost of the curb side service for both grass and tree limbs is costing the sanitation fund \$40,000. It is becoming an almost daily routine where in the past it was

only done two days a week. He is considering opting for a recycle bin for those residents wanting the pickup and using one of the sanitation trucks. Currently the city has two men go around the city picking up the bagged grass, driving to the burn pit and individually unloading the individual bags and disposing of the bags. When the bags contain household garbage, then guys stop and pick up the garbage. Using the bin collection, only one man would be required and all of the loading and unloading would be done by backing the truck to the grass pile and hydraulically emptying the truck. He mentioned that those residents who elect to have the bin collected could be charged a monthly fee for the service or they can still take their grass clippings to the burn site themselves. Tree limbs could still be pickup by the city but it needs to have a limitation of when and how often this service is done.

He is mentioning it only as an option that should be explored. He'll get more information from cities using the system.

Review and Approval of Minutes:
